Mary trained as a nurse at the Nuffield Orthopaedic Centre, Oxford and Guy's Hospital, London. After obtaining a degree in Psychology in 1982 she set up and led one of the first three part-time degrees in the UK for qualified nurses. She was awarded a Research Studentship by the Department of Health for a Masters Degree in Social Research which she followed with a PhD from Goldsmiths College, University of London. An exhibition of her PhD formed part of the Edinburgh Science Festival. She has held public appointments in England in career paths for nurses, midwives and health visitors, and in Scotland on distinction awards. Since retiring from healthcare, she has become interested in the history of the police, particularly 1900 – 1920.

Mary has been a member of the Royal Philosophical Society of Glasgow since 2011. As a member of the Society's Web Group she established the link with archiving services at the University of Strathclyde for recorded lectures.
