Lecturer/Senior Lecturer in Theoretical Physics at Warwick University from 1970 - 1985 with long breaks at IBM Thomas J Watson Research Centre, New York; Physics Department, North Texas University; and the Niels Bohr Institute in Copenhagen. Affiliated full professor of physics in Colorado State University from 1979-1984. Since 1977 main research in Nanoelectronics and Nano-science. Professor of Electronics in the University of Glasgow 1985-2008 where he set up the Theory section of the Nanoelectronics Research Centre. Fellow of the Royal Society of Edinburgh (1990), Fellow of the Royal Astronomical Society (1999). Long standing interests in Foundations of Quantum Mechanics, Astronomy/Space Science, Philosophy of Science. Set up a unique undergraduate course in Physics and Philosophy at Warwick University.
